Cooperation in Nuclear Emergency

Purpose	For ensuring prompt response by making the most of geographical proximity, dispatch staff and provide material and equipment mutually
Main Contents	 1 . Dispatch staff In addition to existing cooperation agreement, dispatching additional 100 to 200 staff in total Environmental radiation monitoring, and radiation dose examination to those who evacuating Support for public relations at branch office and customer service office Drive a transport vehicle which goes to power stations 2 . Provide material and equipment In addition to increasing the expendables to be provided based on existing cooperation agreement, provide material and equipment that each company can do (Ex.) Heavy equipment for removing debris, Tank lorry, Tyvek suit etc. 3 . Give a affected company counsel through video conference by Manager of nuclear department 4 . Mutually Participate in drills that each company conducts on a regular basis

Cooperation in Decommissioning of Nuclear Reactors

Purpose: For ensuring further safety in decommissioning, and adequacy in responding NRA's review
 Main Contents: Consider technical and procuring cooperation in huge construction, and share information related to decommissioning

Cooperation in Establishing the Facility for Dealing with Specific Severe Accident

Purpose: For ensuring further safety in establishing the facility for dealing with specific severe accident, and adequacy in responding NRA's review

>Main Contents: Consider unifying specifications of facilities, and share information related to the first track plant
