



# Snapshot of Kyushu


Area (As of October 1, 2015)


Population (As of October 1, 2015)


Nominal Gross Regional Product (Fiscal 2013)


IC production value (fiscal 2015)


Automobile production (fiscal 2015)


Crude steel production (fiscal 2015)
